NO BOOKINGS can be made at Hawequas

BOOKINGS can only be made by paying the deposit of R300 - or R150 Group hold fee, (R600 for non-members) payable to Scout HQ. The deposit will be refunded provided no damage or littering is reported and all your garbage is removed. The deposit will not be refunded if you cancel or postpone your booking.

FULL PAYMENT is due a minimum of 7 days prior to the arrival date of your booking. Send proof of payment to Regional HQ. Please make sure of the final number of people in your party before then.

PRECEDENCE (does not apply to camping)

A last minute booking of a facility that pays up in full, will have precedence over a booking that has not made full payment within 7 days prior to the arrival date of the booking. The party standing to lose their booking will be advised telephonically.

ON ARRIVAL the person responsible for the group is to report to the on site Manager in order to:

1. Collect and sign for the facility keys.
2. Hand in proof of authorisation to use the site.
3. Sign responsibility for reporting any damages to the Manager, leaving the facilities clean and tidy and removing your garbage.
4. Sign acknowledgement that you have read and will abide by the rules of the facility.
5. Schedule a time for a departure inspection by the on site Manager.

GATE KEY (If required) The gate is open Mon – Fri 07h00 – 18h00, Sat 08h00 – 18h00 and Sun by appointment only.
An additional R50 deposit for (each) a key is payable in cash at the on Site Manager on collection of a key and refunded on key return.

SAFETY & RULES

The **Scout Law & Promise** and the organisations **Child Protection Policy** apply above all else.

Swimming buddy system – you may only make use of the cement swimming dam or rock pools if there are more than **four** people in your group. If there are adults in the party, at least one must be present during all swimming activities.

Everyone in your party must familiarise themselves with the **emergency procedures and phone numbers** upon arrival.

Report all damages caused or irregularities to the resident Manager immediately. Vandalism will not be tolerated. Vandals will be blacklisted and never allowed back on Hawequas.

Please **tidy up** before you depart and **take all refuse home** with you. The buildings on site are not serviced.

Do not move furniture, mattresses or equipment housed inside buildings or under roofed areas. This will be subject to a fine.

Do not remove anything from Hawequas premises without the prior permission of the on site Manager.

No vegetation or trees (including aliens) may be damaged or cut down without the permission of the on site Manager.

No fires are permitted outside the camping areas or the immediate vicinity of the buildings. Fires must be made in a suitable fire-place, attended AT ALL TIMES and properly extinguished.

Do not tamper with any water channels, pipes, filters, tanks, taps, fittings, hoses, connections or irrigation systems. **Damage to water pipes** (e.g. Hammering a tent peg into one) must be reported immediately as the entire facility could run out of water. Same goes for gas installations and equipment.

NO SMOKING allowed inside any building on site. Same applies for near or in site of any youth using the site. Smoking is bad for you.

No firearms, loud music, pets or alcohol is allowed on site.

Keep the main sliding entrance gate closed at all times.

ACCOMMODATION FACILITIES & RATES

As at 1 October 2015

All rates are charged at per day night rates except day visit.

Day Visits Individual: Picnic, braai, hiking, swimming.

Members – Free (Groups 10+ = R10 pp); Non-members – R30 each

Camping Overnight: Water taps, ablation blocks, hot showers.

Note: Buildings and camping are separate entities if using both.

Members – R25, Non-members – R50

Ole House: 18 beds, 2 bathrooms, activity/dining room, large kitchen.

Members – R960, Non-members – R1 750

Barn Hall only: 1 large indoor lecture or activity hall (2 bunks)

Members – R150, Non-members – R250

Barn Bunkhouse only: 15 bunk beds, adjacent ablation block

Members – R600, Non-members – R1 100

Robert Hall Campsite: Bunkroom (4 bunk beds), kitchen, Braai,

raised covered dining/activity platform, site, ablation block nearby.

Members – R360, Non-members – R750 (both less 10 campers)

Rondawel: 4 beds, stove, fridge, sink, table & chairs - rustic

Members – R120, Non-members – R220

Wood Cabin: 8 bunk beds, ablutions and kitchenette.

Members – R280, Non-members – R520

Cottage: 4 beds, 2 bedrooms, ablation, living room, kitchenette.

Members – R320, Non-members – R480

Tiger's Village: 8 beds, 2 buildings, rustic & rough 'camp style'

Members – R220, Non-members – R420

Whole Farm: One set price for hiring the entire site per day night

Members – R3 000, Non-members – R5 500 (100+ Add Campfees)

Non-members: Anyone who is not a registered member of Scouts and Girl Guides South Africa. Prices are negotiable with valid reason/s.

*Bookings of 3+ nights receive a 20% discount (Excludes Regional Bookings). 10% discount for off peak periods (outside WC school, public holidays and weekends). **Members not up to date with membership fees will pay Non-Member prices.***

OTHER FACILITIES

Cement swim dam, river with granite rock pools, floodlit grass playing fields, 10km of mountain hiking trails, possible abseiling site.

FREE ACCESS FOR MEMBERS

FREE DAY VISITS for all members (Groups of 10+ = R10 pp).

- Notify Area HQ a week in advance and / or contact the site Manager.

- Advisable to get a gate key from HQ or check gate open times

- No access to House, Barn, Bunkhouse or hire buildings included

- Paying users have preference for using facilities (e.g. dam)

- Normal activity regulations apply – Consent & Activity forms
