

Senior Cub Camp Kit List

For travel

• Cubs are to travel, arrive and depart in Cub uniform

To be handed in at registration on arrival

- Signed consent form paper copy
- 4 pack of muffins
- Medication (if applicable) must be in a clear packet, clearly marked with instructions and name. Please ensure that any medication sent is noted on the consent form, as we are not allowed to administer any medication without it being noted first. Cubs are also, under no circumstances, allowed to self-medicate.

For sleeping

- Sleeping bag and pillow
- Small mattress (hike or camp style no stretchers or large inflatable mattresses)
- Tents will be provided

Camp kit (to fit into one bag that the Cub can carry on their own)

- Toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, comb, facecloth, soap) in a proper bag
- Mess kit (plate, bowl, mug, knife, fork, spoon, tea towel) in a proper bag
- Torch, spare batteries (the torch is very important please test it)
- Campfire blanket (if you have one)
- Takkies or other closed shoes (open shoes like crocs or slops are NOT allowed on camp at all)
- Socks, clean undies for 2 days (although they always come home clean ©)
- Long pants and warm top
- Shorts
- T-shirts (2x)
- Hat (preferably floppy type, not peak cap)
- Raincoat / windbreaker
- Sunscreen
- Sleep attire
- Swimming costume and towel

EVERYTHING MUST BE CLEARLY MARKED WITH CHILD'S NAME - PLEASE!

NOT ALLOWED: Penknives, anything electronic, cell phones, matches or lighters, money, toys, sweets, tuck of any kind (will be confiscated). Please, do **NOT** pack food items of any kind - the camp is fully catered. Food items packed could cause baboons to raid the tents!

It is the **Cub's** duty to know what is his/hers and to take responsibility for their property.
